





They started with the small introduction about themselves and Sula Vineyards. Later gave a brief on wine production at Sula. An Appreciation session followed with Sula Sauvignon Blanc, Sula Merlot & Sula Brut. Food & wine Harmony,4's of tasting Notes Were demonstrated by the Sommelier to the students.

Sommelier & Proprietor of Vinsura Wine Mr. Vikrant Holkar guided tour of the vineyards, where students learned about grape varieties, soil types, climate conditions, and the cultivation techniques used, harvesting process, from manual picking to the machine-driven alternatives.

Visit of delegates from Japanese Ship Owners Association

We conducted a batch of Japanese Ships cook course with 10 candidates from 29th April 2024 to 3rd May 2024. Nomura San and Fujimera San from Japanese Ship Owners association along with two representatives from Japanese Maritime Administration and two representatives from NYK Ship management visited our campus to observe the program. They attended the course from 1st to 3rd May 2024. The purpose of their visit was to assess the possibility of issuing Japanese Ships cook course certificate to CCMC Candidates who pass out from our Institution so that they are eligible for Japanese COC for cooks.

Short term courses

After a break of 3 years, we restarted the Culinary Skills Enhancement Program for Anglo Eastern Ship Management candidates. 16 students attended the course in the first batch which commenced from 20th May 2024.

14 candidates attended Familiarization Training in International cuisine from 11th to 15th April 2024. 17 candidates attended this course from 16th to 20th May 2024 and 11 candidates attended from 13th to 17th June 2024.

5 candidates from Campbell shipping attended Multicuisine training program from 20th to 25th May 2024. During the same period 2 candidates from K Line Ship management attended Safe food handling and Nutrition course.

Admissions

60 students took admission in BSc Maritime Hospitality Studies batch no: 16 and 36 students took admission in BA Culinary Arts batch No 9. The commencement address for students and parents was organized on 6th July 2024. Around 200 parents attended the event. Classes for both batches commenced from 8th July. 70 students were enrolled in to CCMC Course batch no 36. The classes commenced from 1st July 2024.

- 1. The new academic session, 2023-2024 commenced from 3rd April.
- 2. The School Management Committee meeting was held on 06th April to review the school's progress and to pass the budget for the academic year 2024-25.

- 8. The results of Std. XII and X CBSE Board examination results were announced on the 13th of May. Mast. Samar Gharat topped the Science Stream by securing 91% of marks followed by Ms. Siddhi Bhoir scoring 82%. Mast. Pranjal Koli topped the Commerce Stream by securing 86.4% of marks followed by Mast. Hritivij Koli and Ms.Ruchita Bhoir scored 85.6%. We got an overall 93% pass percentage.
- 9. 92 students from our school registered for the Class X examination and this year, we reaped 100% results for our school. We feel extremely proud to announce that 28 students secured Distinction, 35 students 1st Class, and 21students 2nd Class. Ms. Snehal Koli topped the school by securing 91.67% followed by Mast. 
