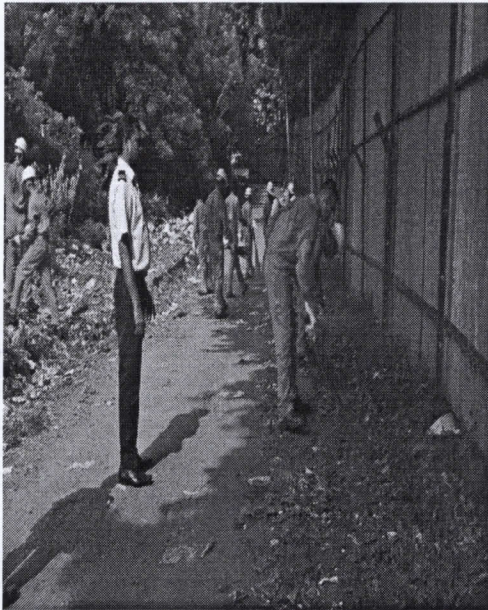

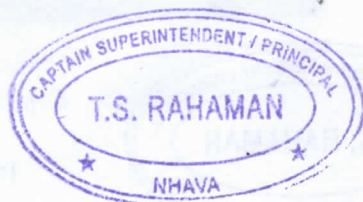

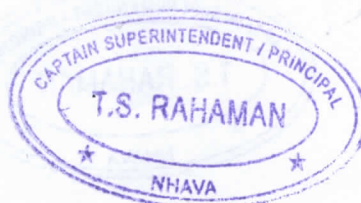
MARITIME AWARENESS RUN

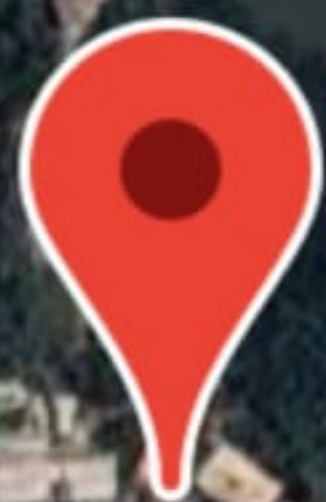
