Marine Museum



The Marine Museum Internship programme was carried out from 20th January to 28th January 2023 with five students perusing MFA Museology from Maharaja Sayajirao University, Vadodara. The aim of the internship was for the students to gain experience in the marine museum and to help with the documentation project. By the end of the internship the students documented a total of 830 museum objects.



A workshop on the basics of Museum Documentation was carried out by Ms. Abhiruchi Oke, Sr. Archivist, Eka Resources and documentation consultant for the Marine Museum on 21st and 22nd Jan 2023. The students were introduced to documentation sheets, accessioning number system and labelling methods by showing them the various tools required to work with artefacts like archival pens, dry brushes, label stickers and page turners. After which the documentation of a wall hanging carpet and dry brushing of 8 old maps was carried out.



Mr. Manoj Choudhari, curator, Natural History Dept, CSMVS, Mumbai visited the museum as a conservator for the curative conservation of our wet specimens on 26th Jan 2023. Formalin for 13 wet specimens was replaced. He also demonstrated the dry brushing of taxidermy specimens. Labelling of the snake specimens was also carried out.



On 27th Jan 2023, an outreach program was carried out for the students of 9th STD of LKM School. The purpose of the program was to introduce the students to various museums, museum personnel, the subject of museology and to give them one more avenue to explore as a career option in the future.
